PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project improved the visibility of the crosswalk and warns motorists of the presence of pedestrians with a flashing beacon and illuminated pedestrian sign activated by a pedestrian button on each side of the roadway.

POINTS OF INTEREST

Located next to Sir Francis Drake High School, this intersection provides connectivity across Sir Francis Drake Boulevard to neighborhoods to the north. Since there was no signal at this intersection, pedestrians were challenged in crossing Sir Francis Drake safely. Sidewalks on Saunders Avenue also provide access to Center Boulevard and are a key north-south link in this area.

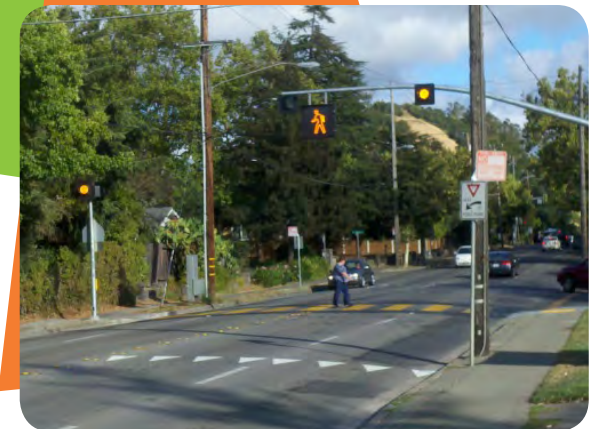
