Gate Six Road at Bridgeway, Sausalito

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project was identified to make various operational improvements to the intersection to reduce movement conflicts between cyclists, pedestrians, and motor vehicles. The greatest area of conflict is at the northeast corner of the intersection where a Class I path ends.

POINTS OF INTEREST

This intersection is extremely busy, serving as the northern gateway to Sausalito, the only access to Marin City, the on- and off-ramps to Highway 101, and is the southern terminus of the Mill Valley-Sausalito path. With the connection to the path, this intersection sees significant pedestrian and cyclist activity as it is the link between Sausalito and San Francisco to the south with the rest of Marin County to the north.

STATUS

Project is inactive. Caltrans declined to pursue further at this time.

WalkBikeMarin is an initiative by the County of Marin to help make Marin more healthy, livable, and environmentally sustainable by encouraging walking and bicycling as everyday transportation.
