PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will provide a pedestrian and cycling path to connect Bridgeway to the Sausalito Ferry Terminal, currently separated by a large parking lot. The waiting area for ferry passengers is minimal such that queues frequently spill out into the parking lot. Providing a clear and attractive path of travel will improve access to the ferry terminal as well as aesthetically enhance this major activity area.

POINTS OF INTEREST

This area of downtown is extremely busy with residents and tourists alike, many of whom use the ferry to get to and from San Francisco. The pathway would provide an attractive link to the shops and restaurants from the ferry landing and improve public amenities around the ferry landing.
