LOCATION

Pastori Avenue between Center Boulevard and Sir Francis Drake Boulevard (Fairfax)

COST

\$50,000 (estimated)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will provide a new sidewalk on the east side of Pastori Avenue, connecting the sidewalk on Sir Francis Drake with Center Boulevard and Fair Anselm Shopping Center. Currently pedestrians must either walk in the street or through the parking lot of the adjacent shopping center to traverse this corridor.

POINTS OF INTEREST

Pastori Avenue is a narrow street and is a primary vehicle connector between the two major east-west roadways in the area. Short segments of existing sidewalk have heaved from adjacent tree routes making passage difficult at best while other sections have no sidewalk at all. The new sidewalk will connect the neighborhoods north and east of the Fair Anselm center to the shopping center, public transportation hub, and downtown Fairfax via the new Center Blvd Promenade.

STATUS

Negotiations are under way for an easement for the portion of the project that will be on private property.

ABOUT WALKBIKEMARIN

WalkBikeMarin is an initiative by the County of Marin to help make Marin more healthy, livable, and environmentally sustainable by encouraging walking and bicycling as everyday transportation. This initiative was catalyzed by a recent \$25 million federal grant to fund the Nonmotorized Transportation Pilot Program (NTPP).
