

# Bicycle Parking

**LOCATION:** Countywide

**COST:** \$132,000 (Marin County); \$163,000 (GGBHTD)

**FUNDING SOURCE:** NTPP \$295,000

**COMPLETION SCHEDULE:** Aug, 2011 (County); Aug, 2012 (GGBHTD, projected)

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project was intended to fund bicycle racks and lockers at various locations throughout the county. Due to federal funding processes it was determined that using NTPP monies for a countywide bicycle parking program was infeasible. In light of this, a separate grant was pursued and awarded from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA). A portion of the originally allocated NTPP funds has been divided into two projects:

☒ Five locations have been identified on County property to receive federal funds as demonstration projects to illustrate the challenges of using federal funds for scattered, small-scale projects. The intent is to provide necessary documentation to encourage modification to federal policies related to small-scale projects. Marin County is the lead for this.

☒ The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway, and Transportation District will be installing additional bicycle parking facilities at the San Rafael Transit Center and the Larkspur Ferry Terminal.

## POINTS OF INTEREST

Having parking facilities for cyclists at various destinations is key to increasing bicycle riding for everyday trips. The two major transit hubs in the county already see significant usage by cyclists, in some cases resulting in bicycles being locked to trees and lampposts. Between these two projects and the separate TFCA funding program for individual locations it is anticipated that over 2,000 additional bicycle parking spaces (via racks or lockers) will be added county-wide.

## STATUS

County projects are completed. Engineering and design work is under way for Golden Gate locations with construction planned for summer of 2012.
