- Enable your community or group to voice their needs to local transit planners
- Provide information on tickets, discount fares, transfers, and TransLink®
- Give attendees free tickets to try local transit

- Help plan a trip for you
- Escort you on a transit trip
- Relay route and schedule issues back to Marin Transit
- Explain how to pay fares, where to buy tickets and how to use TransLink

How do I sign up?

Call Marin Transit at 415-499-6099

What happens next?

1) Telephone Screening

Marin Transit will call to get information about your travel needs

2) Welcome Packet

If fixed route transit can meet your needs, and space is available, Marin Transit will enroll you in the program

3) Meet your Ambassador

Your ambassador will contact you

4) Take a Transit Trip

Try transit with your ambassador

5) Resolve Problems

Report back to your ambassador and Marin Transit to resolve problems
